Dear parents

We welcomed some prospective parents to school on Monday and showed them around our lovely little school (we made sure we remained socially distanced and school was well ventilated.) The children were all exemplary with years 2 and 3 reciting how brilliant our school is because everyone is kind, they love Forest School and learn lots all the time. We hadn't even prompted them or told them what to say! Please continue to share any good news you have about school on social media as it has a huge impact on our reputation.

Usually I try to keep this missive very positive but I do just want to have a little moan about punctuality. We ring the bell just before 9am so that we can register and start lessons by 9.05am. Children who arrive late feel awkward and may have missed important instructions and also time to transition into school with their friends. Please be on time. You are welcome on the playground from 8.45am and a member of staff will be out on duty from 8.50am. Years 1 to 6 parents, you are welcome to leave once a member of staff is on duty; we will look after your children until the bell goes and it might help with the car parking if people leave once their children are safely inside the gate.

We have had some nasty sickness bugs and colds going around school. Clearly, if your child is unwell, you must keep them off. The current situation makes it rather difficult to talk about attendance and how important school is. When they miss only a few days, they can easily get behind with their work and they miss out on social interaction. On the one hand, we want to encourage you to send your children in, even if they have a cold or sore throat (calpol helps) as they can still learn with a sniffle and they miss out on playing with friends as well as important learning. On the other hand, we have to advise you to be mindful of COVID symptoms and not send your child in if they have a cough etc. If your child does display symptoms then please do a LF test on them. If it is negative and they are well enough to play on an ipad and hold a conversation, then please send them into school. Obviously, there is no easy answer to this problem but we are always happy to advise if you call
