We follow *The National Curriculum* for all subjects. The learning objectives for each year group in Maths, English and Science are covered explicitly in the year stated, even though they will be taught through our whole school topics and won't necessarily be covered in the same order as in the National Curriculum. Teachers plan in a flexible way to ensure all children make progress from their different starting points.

For example, in year 2, children will be taught the following objective when it is stated in the termly overview that children are learning about fractions:

*recognise, find and name a half as one of two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity*
