3.1. Free School Meals Application Process

From 10th January 2020 parents and carers can apply online for Free School Meals (FSM) and get an immediate decision for their entitlement.

The application is made through the same portal that the parent/carer applies for a school place and can be applied for at the same time.

The FSM will begin once the school place has been confirmed and attendance has commenced.

If anyone thinks they may be eligible, please do apply, even if your child is in Reception or KS1, as school will benefit financially if the FSM are granted. We receive extra money in the form of the Pupil Premium grant for every child entitled to free school meals.
