Dear parents

Only one week of home-schooling left for some of you! We are really excited to be welcoming all the children back to school on the 8th March and hope that we all remain safe and well learning together. I have adjusted our COVID risk assessment in line with government advice and all the measures of control necessary are in place to stop the spread of the virus as far as possible.

These include:

- Frequent handwashing for at least 20 seconds by all children, staff and visitors.
- Use of a catch it, bin, it, kill it approach.
- Wearing of masks – staff in corridors, parents at drop off and collection, visiting contractors/workmen.
- Social distancing between staff.
- Staff doing a lateral flow test twice weekly
- Children all facing the same way in class and at lunchtimes.
- High level of ventilation in all classrooms, office and staff room.
- Frequent cleaning of whole school and high traffic areas during the day.
- Reduced amount of equipment shared between children.
- Staggered drop off and pick up times.
