We started in the Space Pavilion and explored 'The Science of Jodrell Bank' exhibition. We looked at radio waves, how the Lovell telescope works and even took selfies with the infrared camera! The children were fascinated by the First Light Pavilion, where they could dress up, smell the gooseberries of Jodrell and partake in interactive exhibits. The highlight of the day, however, was without a doubt the Space Dome. The children were invited into the dome with other schools to watch constellations played across the ceiling, hop from planet to planet and appreciate the vast beauty of our solar system. Each child thoroughly enjoyed the trip and behaved impeccably, deepening their knowledge and love of the topic. It was a pleasure to take them on such a fascinating trip and they were a credit to our school. Well done Class 3!
